Children should have muscle strength and dexterity in their hands and fingers before manipulating a pencil on paper. Here are some fun activities children can do at home to develop these important skills.

The following activities involve the use of manipulatives (available at home) to support young children's fine motor development, and will help to build the strength and dexterity necessary to hold a pencil appropriately.

Strengthen small muscles of hands and wrist – Activities @ home

- Rolling, cutting shapes, making objects with Play-dough/Atta dough
- Painting
- Playing with sponges (water squeezing)
- Picking Chana/Rajma dal with thumb & index fingers/ tweezer / spoon
- Water play.
- Gardening and planting.
- Pouring water from one container to another.
- Pegging clothes
- Folding clothes
- Squeezing wet clothes
- Zipping, buttoning
- Cutting old newspapers/ magazines using child friendly scissors.

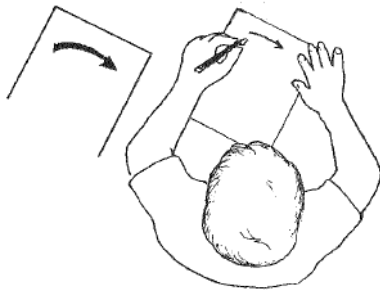
- Picking seeds out of fruits or vegetables like pumpkin, watermelon.
- Picking leaves out of greens like curry leaves, mint
- Stacking cups/bowls, spoons, forks.
- Sand play
- Sharpening pencils/crayons
- Screwing/unscrewing bottle caps/container lids
- Tear old newspaper into stripes and crumble them into balls.
- Turn over cards, coins, buttons on a flat surface
- Cut fruits or vegetables using child friendly knives.

Below is the guideline for proper paper placement & pencil skills

Paper Placement & Pencil Skills

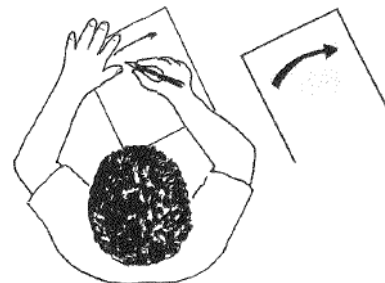
LEFT-HANDED

Place the **left** corner higher.

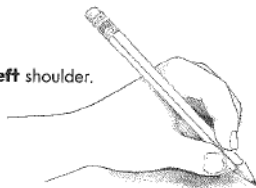


RIGHT-HANDED

Place the **right** corner higher.

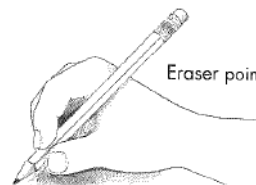


Eraser points to **left** shoulder.



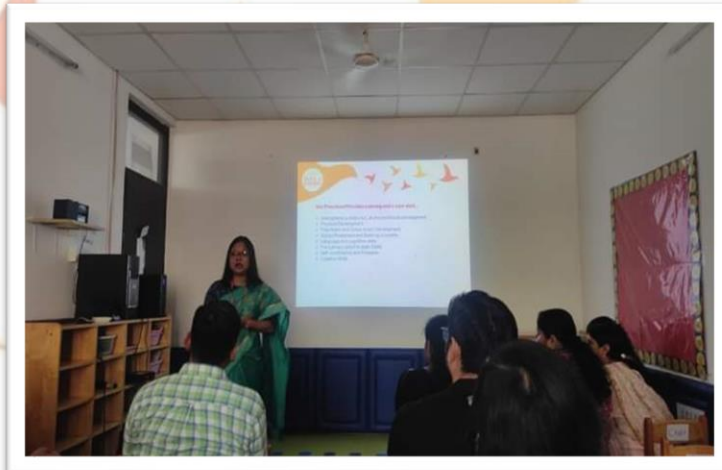
Standard grip: Hold pencil with

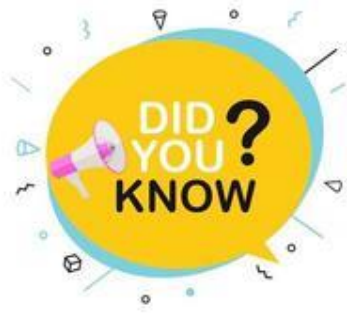
