"Bilingualism is an incredible gift to give a child. It goes beyond just learning another language. It broadens mental development, thought patterns and world perspective."

Language learning is a non-stop process. It is the way by which we communicate with each other, build relationships, and creating a feeling of community.

Below are the few ways by which parent can help the child, when home and school language are different

- Read the school language bedtime story
- Listen to school language music/rhymes.
- Read school language news
- Use educational apps on a tablet/mobile phone
- Go shopping with the school language shopping list
- Cook a meal with the school language recipe
- Read a map and give directions in school language
- Play a board game in school language
- Label household items in school language
- Ask your child to teach you something in the school language and allow them to correct you!
- Watch their favourite shows or movies in the school language.
- Meet your child's teacher. She/he can guide you based on your child's stage of school language development.

The stages of language learning for your reference:

Silent Period: Initial exposure where the child listens more than speaking.

Early Production: The child can speak a few words and phrases.

Speech Emergence: Basic sentences start to form.

Intermediate Fluency: Capability to hold basic conversations.

Advanced Fluency: Near-native level proficiency.




